

Appendix E: Educational accommodations assessment

At least once per semester, use this worksheet to assess the extent to which the existing educational accommodations meet the needs of the child with a chronic illness.

What specific steps can I, the parents, or others take to help him or her?	
To what extent are educational accommodations effective?	
What alternatives can I suggest to the child's parents and educational team?	
To what extent are all the educational accommodations available to the child?	
To what extent am I using/ implementing the educational accommodations?	

Questions

<p>To what extent is the child using the educational accommodations? Identify barriers that may prevent him or her from using the educational accommodations.</p>	
<p>To what extent does the child have easy access to you so he or she can get help when needed?</p>	
<p>To what extent is the child absorbing information and participating in class?</p>	
<p>To what extent is the child's academic progress on track, for example, according to his or her IEP goals for the academic year?</p>	
<p>To what extent does the classroom environment contribute to the child's ability to make it through an entire day of school successfully?</p>
